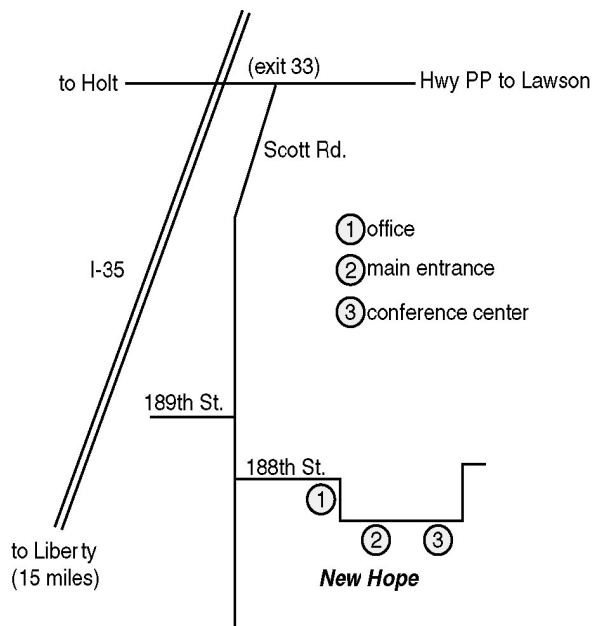
Camp Goals

Complete and send the enclosed registration and health forms with a \$25 deposit to the Clay-Platte Baptist Association by June 27, 2011. Remaining balance due the day camp starts. Registrations received after June 27th will pay Full fee of \$179.00.

You will need ...
